

# THE DANGERS OF TEEN DRIVING



Young drivers between 16 and 24 years of age are at a higher risk of being killed in motor vehicle collisions per distance travelled than all other age groups.



**80%** of young adult passengers who were killed in a speeding crash were in the vehicle with a speeding driver of similar age.



Drivers who use handheld devices are **4X** more likely to get into crashes.

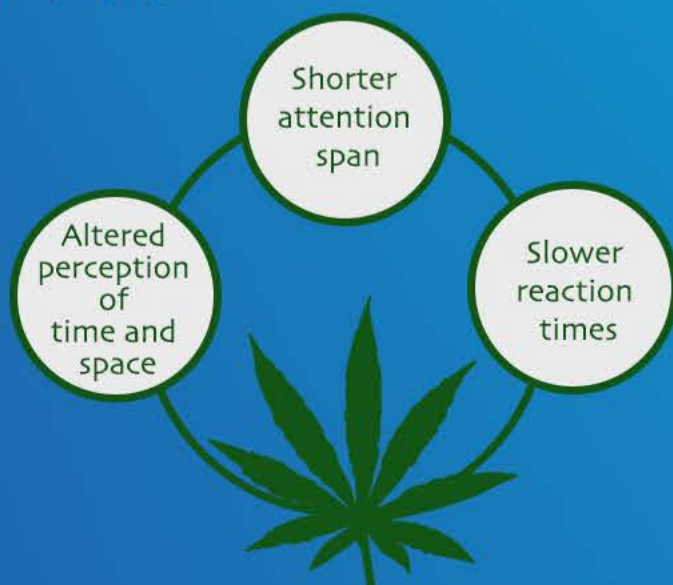
