WHAT IS IT?

The Sweet Life Road Show is a hands-on interactive experience that raises teens' awareness about the deadliest road risks, and shows them simple strategies to stay safe.

This 2 to 2 ½ hour event is offered **free of charge** to high schools across Ontario. It uses methods such as computer gaming and peer theatre to go beyond driver education classes and teach beginner drivers to make safe and strategic decisions.



EVENT SCHEDULE

Strategy Stations

Students are divided into small groups, and circulate around 10 stations addressing:

- Dealing with distractions while driving
- What to say when a friend is driving recklessly
- How to share the road with trucks
- Dealing with roadside emergencies
- How to deal with becoming drowsy while driving
- Why marijuana and driving don't mix
- And much more!
